**SUBJECT:** Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) and Enhanced FMAP

Effective October 1, 2006 the new Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) for the Mental Health Community Medicaid Program will decrease to 59.66%. The new Enhanced FMAP used for the State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP) and the Breast and Cervical Cancer Project (BCCP) will decrease to 71.76%. All services, regardless of service date that are PAID by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services on or after October 1, 2006 will be paid at the revised FMAP. The changes in the FMAP was published in the Federal Register on November 30, 2005

As a reminder, the Medicaid Program's Catalogue of Federal Assistance (CFDA) Number is 93.778. The Breast and Cervical Cancer Program (BCCP) is included in the Medicaid Program CFDA number. The State Children's Insurance Plan (SCHIP) CFDA number is 93.767. Boards need to track the federal reimbursement by CFDA number for audit purposes and federal reporting. The program amount for each program is identified on the voucher report that is mailed with each check to the Board.
