TITLE OF CORRESPONDENCE:
Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) and Enhanced FMAP for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2010

CONTENT:
Effective October 1, 2009, the new Federal Medical Assistance Percentage (FMAP) for the Mental Health Community Medicaid Program will increase to 63.42%. The new Enhanced FMAP used for the State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP) and the Breast and Cervical Cancer Project (BCCP) will increase to 74.39%. All services, regardless of service date that are PAID by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services on or after October 1, 2009 will be paid at the revised FMAP. The changes in the FMAP was published in the Federal Register/Vol. 73, No. 229/Wednesday, November 26, 2008/Notices. This information can be found at <http://aspe.os.dhhs.gov/health/fmap.htm>.

As a reminder, the Medicaid Program's Catalogue of Federal Assistance (CFDA) Number is 93.778. The Breast and Cervical Cancer Program (BCCP) is included in the Medicaid Program CFDA number. The State Children's Insurance Plan (SCHIP) CFDA number is 93.767. Boards need to track the federal reimbursement by CFDA number for audit purposes and federal reporting. The program amount for each program is identified on the voucher report that is mailed to the Board.
